


TITLE: Graphic Technician – Pre-press

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Follow Montebello's pre-press procedures when preparing customer artwork. Ensure that the customer
 artwork meets the minimal printing requirements as outlined in our Graphic Artwork Guidebooks for laminate
 tubes, aerosol cans, and collapsible aluminum tubes. Update information necessary in the Graphic Data Base.
- Perform necessary adjustments to customer electronic artwork files in Adobe Illustrator and/or Photoshop.
- Verify the quality of artwork files done by other graphic technicians, and communicate required adjustments back to them in a business like and professional manner.
- Work with our "stake holders" to make sure graphics are done correctly, and meet Montebello printing requirements. Stake holders being: our customers, sales staff, management, and/or our print technicians in each facility.
- Process artwork approvals. Includes sending proof approval via e-mail, receiving customer approvals, printing
 and mounting final proofs, output plate-ready files and help maintain the level of quality in materials leaving
 the Graphics Department.
- Ensuring the daily maintenance of the Graphic Department's production equipment, such as the ESKO Automation Engine, Nyloflex plate making unit, film negative imagesetter, EPSON color inkjet proofer, graphic server database, and file archiving back-ups are working.
- Destroying old plates, folders, and films at the request of the Quality Control Department.
- Order materials for the graphic department and ensure that the Department has sufficient inventory of all supplies.
- Stay up to date in the latest versions of critical programs and the new tools they offer, in programs such as ESKO Automation Engine, MGMS, Adobe Creative Suite, Microsoft Office Suite, and AutoDesk Design Suite.
- Make emergency printing plates for the production lines, and train plant staff to make plates during nonoffice hours.
- Work with customers to resolve pre-press issues and/or develop methods to meet their needs.
- Ensure the Montebello Quality Control and Production departments receive required documentation when a job is switched-over from one plant to another.
- Prepare and send die lines requested by sales, so that our customers can place their preliminary artwork.
- Develop creative artwork and design requirements for special projects.
- Work on continuous improvement project within the department as required.









- Work overtime or adjusted hours when needed.
- Follow all Montebello work policies.
